

USGA Rules Govern All Play

Except Where Local Rules Apply

- 1. Winter Rules Apply**—In fairway or rough.
Ball may be moved one club length with the club head only, no hands—no penalty.
- 2. Relief From Cart Paths**—Drop ball one club length from the path, no nearer the hole.
- 3. Trees**—No relief. Play as is or Declare Unplayable.
- 4. Unplayable Lie**—One stroke penalty.
Option (1): Move ball one club length any direction no nearer the hole.
Option (2): Move ball back any distance keeping hazard or obstacle in line with hole.
Option (3): Move ball back to spot of previous stroke.
- 5. Out of Bounds**—Entire perimeter of golf course and road on hole #1, #10 & #18—you must replay a ball at the spot from which the original ball was last played—(penalty: one stroke and distance).
- 6. In Course Out of Bounds**—Defined by white stakes: #1 right, #2 right & left, #5 left, #11 left, #12 left, #14 left and #15 left—play ball in your own fairway at nearest point where it went out—penalty: one stroke.
- 7. Unplayable Hazards**—Marked by red stakes: # 5 right, #6 right/left and behind the green, #7 right and left, #8 right and left, #18 right (swamp area)—one stroke penalty. Declare Unplayable as outlined in above Rule #4—one stroke penalty.
- 8. Water Hazards**—Hole 2, 3, 4, 9, 12, 13 and 14—Marked by yellow stakes. Drop ball point of entry, no closer to the hole—one stroke penalty.
- 9. Free Drop On Hole #4 From “Golden Oak” Sign Area.**
